

International Program (1/7)

Conducted an International Young-Scientists
Conference on IRDR, Future Earth and
Sustainability, Oct 22-24, 2013

Young Scientists' Conference

on Integrated Research on Disaster Risk, Future Earth & Sustainability



22 - 24 October 2013 IRDR International Center of Excellence - Taipei Academia Sinica, Taiwan Participated by 42 young scientists (under 35 years of age) from 11 countries

International Program (4/7)

- Co-sponsor the World Social Science Seminar, "Decision-making under conditions of uncertainty," Dec. 7-15, 2013 in New Zealand
 - Co-sponsors: ISSC, IRDR-ICoE, IRDR RIA working Group, START, and Royal Society of New Zealand
 - Objective: Participants will explore how the RIA conceptual framework for response to natural hazards can be integrated across disciplines and cultural contexts.
 - Participants: 25 Fellows from 18 countries were selected from 109 applications from around the world





International Program (5/7)

- Developed a draft multi-year research proposal on IRDR in Southeast Asia: A Trans-boundary Research and Capacity Building Program (NCDR and START)
 - Strengthening high-quality IRDR-pertinent research in the Southeast Asia
 - Enhancing research capacity, including human resource enhancement and institutional strengthening and collaboration
 - Ensuring that there is a policy impact





International Program (6/7)

- Developed a report on "Forensic Investigation of Typhoon Morakot, Taiwan" (NCDR)
 - Completed Chinese-version of the FORIN report
 - Completed 95% of the English-version of the report
- Supported a Visiting Scientists program
 - Dr. Kuan-Hui Lin, Clark University, Worcester, Massachusetts, March 2013-Feb 2014
- Developed a Proposed new IRDR Project on Disaster Risk Reduction and Loss Mitigation

Domestic Program

- Domestic IRDR-related research projects
 - Mega-seismic risk and multi-geological disasters in Taiwan
 - Impact of Climate and Land Use Change on Environmental Hazards and Adaptation
 - Open ISDM: Open Information Systems for Disaster Management
 - Vulnerability Assessment for Heat Wave and Relevant Adaptation Strategy Recommendations
- Continue to promote and coordinate domestic DRR related science and technology activities





Future Plan (1/2)

- Plan to host 3 Advanced Institutes in 2014
 - Psychological Intervention after Disasters
 - Forensic Investigation of Disasters (II)
 - Disaster Risk Reduction and Loss Mitigation
- Plan to co-sponsor a WSS seminar in sustainable urbanization series in Taiwan in September 2014
- Continue to support visiting scientists and research fellows program
 - > Dr. Chris Lennerd, University of Cape Town, South Africa
 - Other potential visiting scientists
- Collaborate with IRDR-Japan project on Social Resilience Building against Disasters by Total Design





Future Plan (2/2)

- Continue to cooperate with international and domestic organizations to organize symposia, training workshops and other disaster-related scientific activities for capacity building
- Continue to build a partnership network of IRDR-related research in Taiwan and the international scientific community.
- Continue to support IRDR and ICSU Programs (e.g.,Future Earth)
