





- Hosted by the Institute for Advanced Sustainability Studies



## Transformations to sustainability

#### Shifting science policy narratives

- Mid 1940s 50s: Science, the Endless Frontier
- Late 1960s 80s: Strategic R&D Programming
- 1990s onwards: The Knowledge Economy
- Today: Towards science for a sustainable and just world?

#### The science-society relationship:

- From science and society ...
- to science for society
- and now science with society

### The link between research, policy and practice:

- From the linear model
- to iterative interaction, feedback loops
- .... and messy processes on both sides
