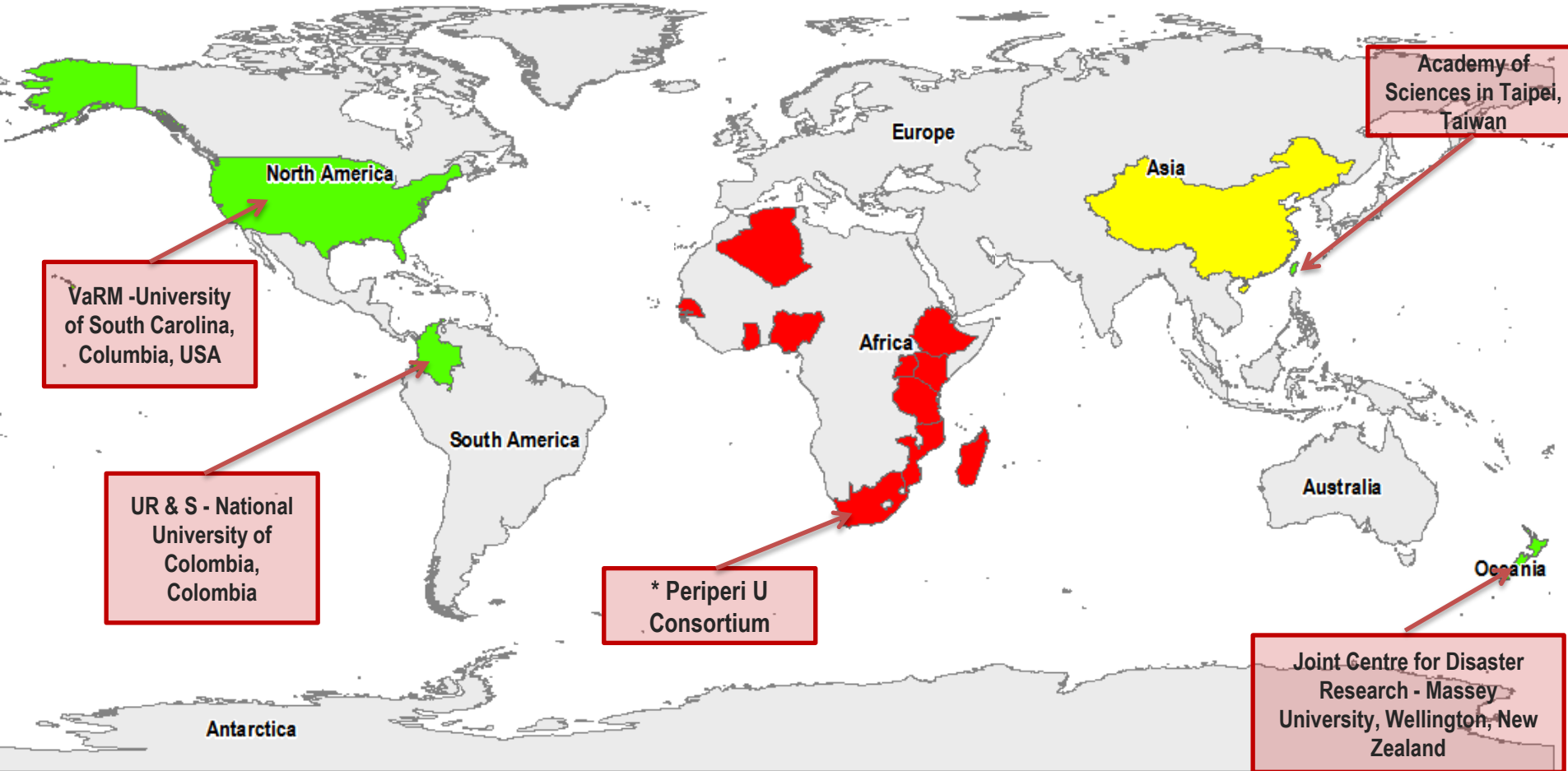

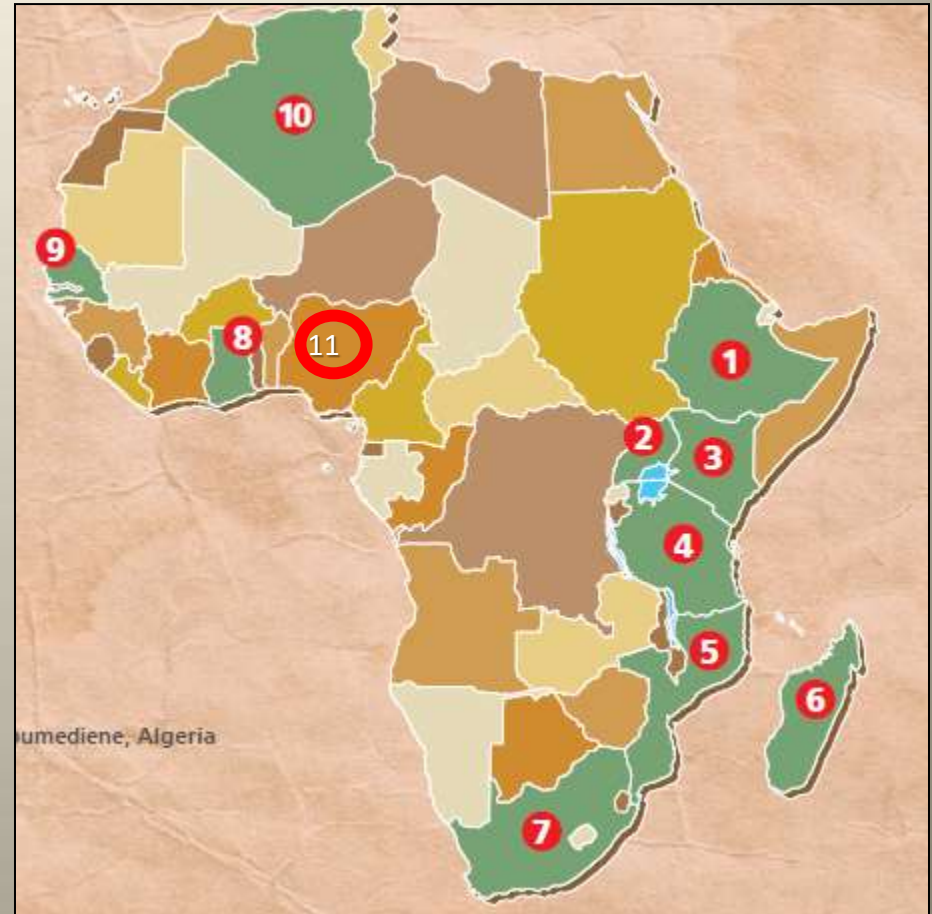

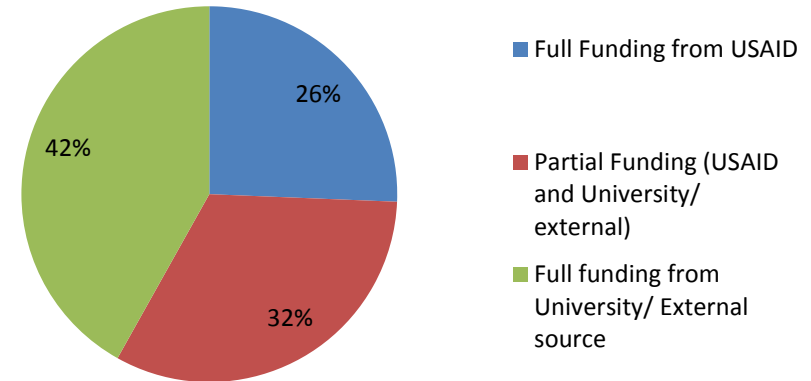

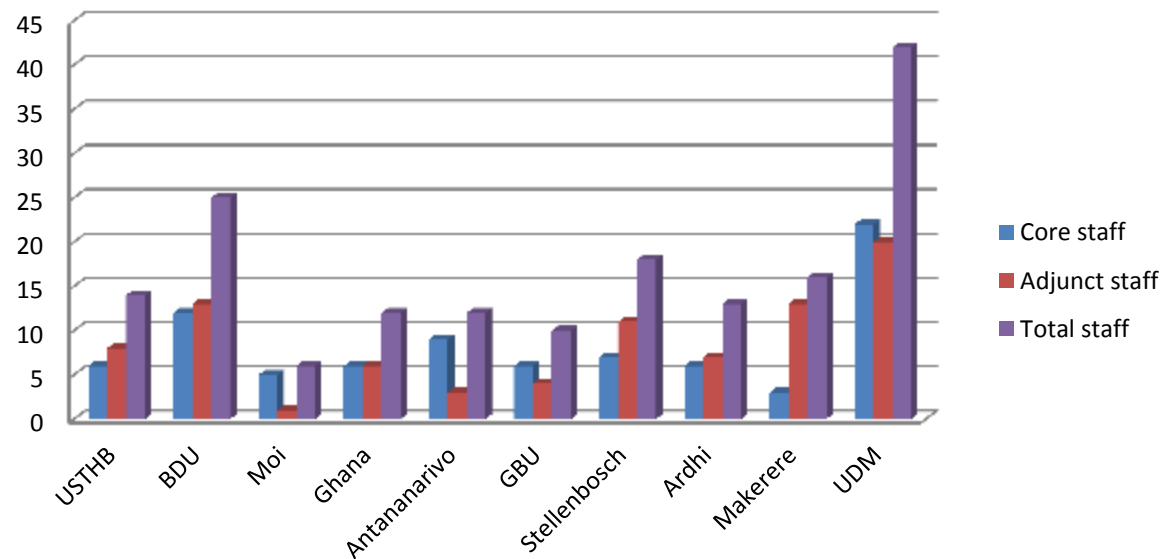

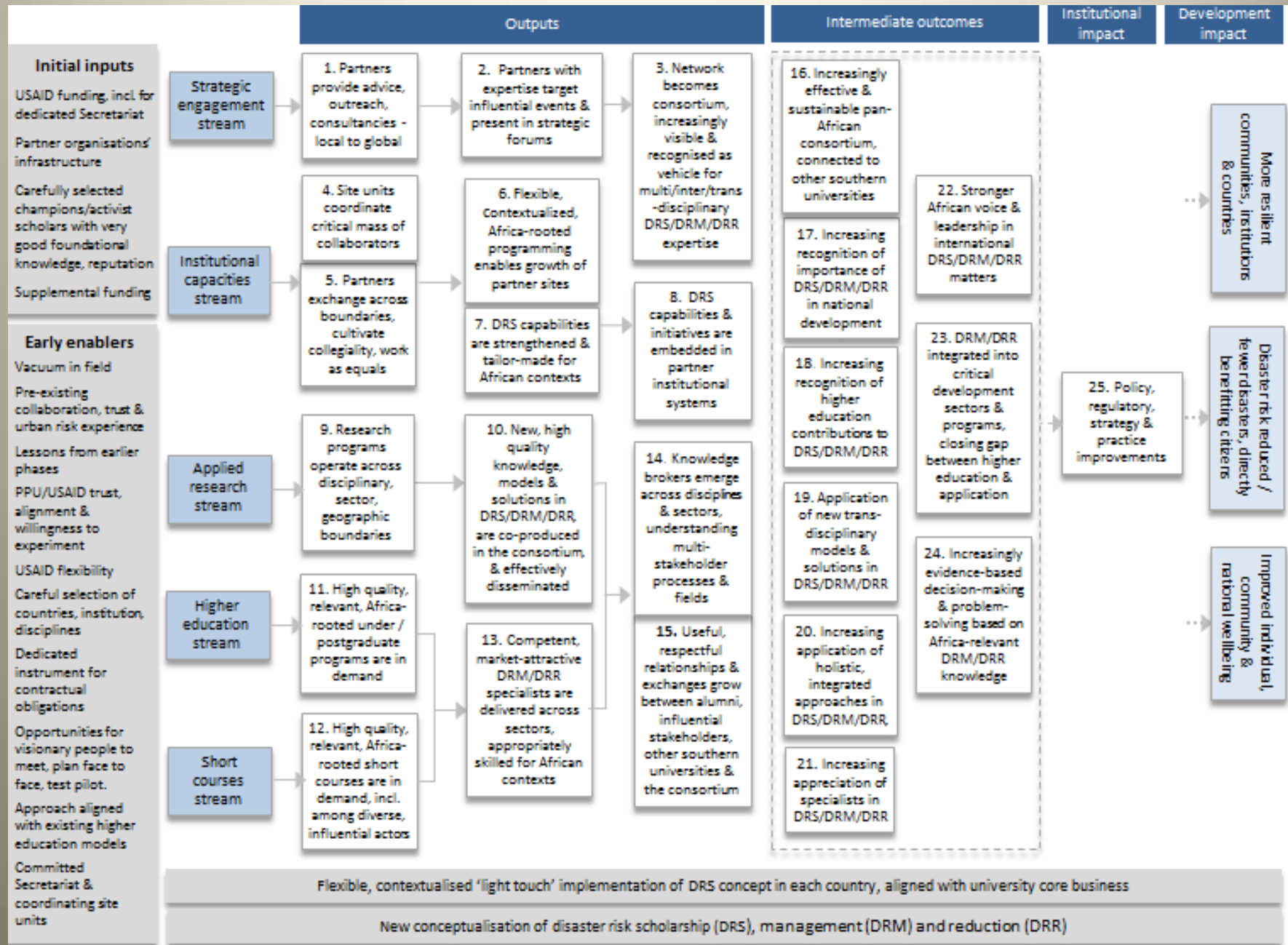
Periperi U Partner Staff Salary Sources

Logic Model for Purposive Engagement of HEIs

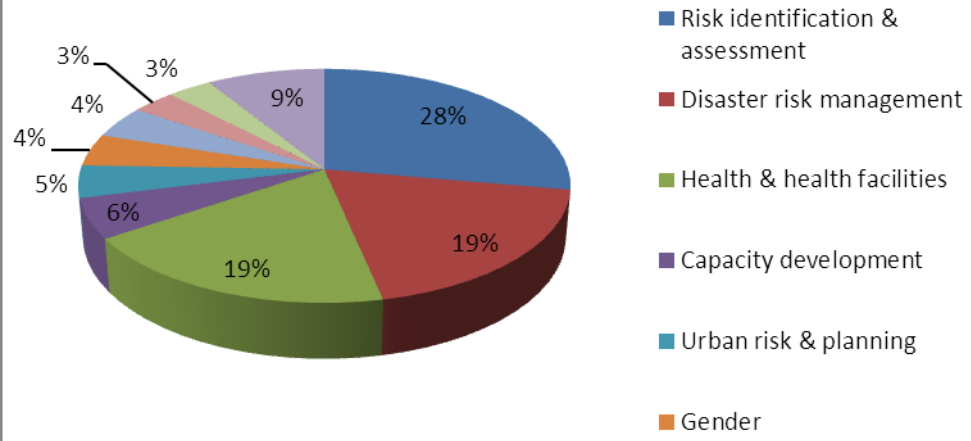


Achievements 2011-2014?

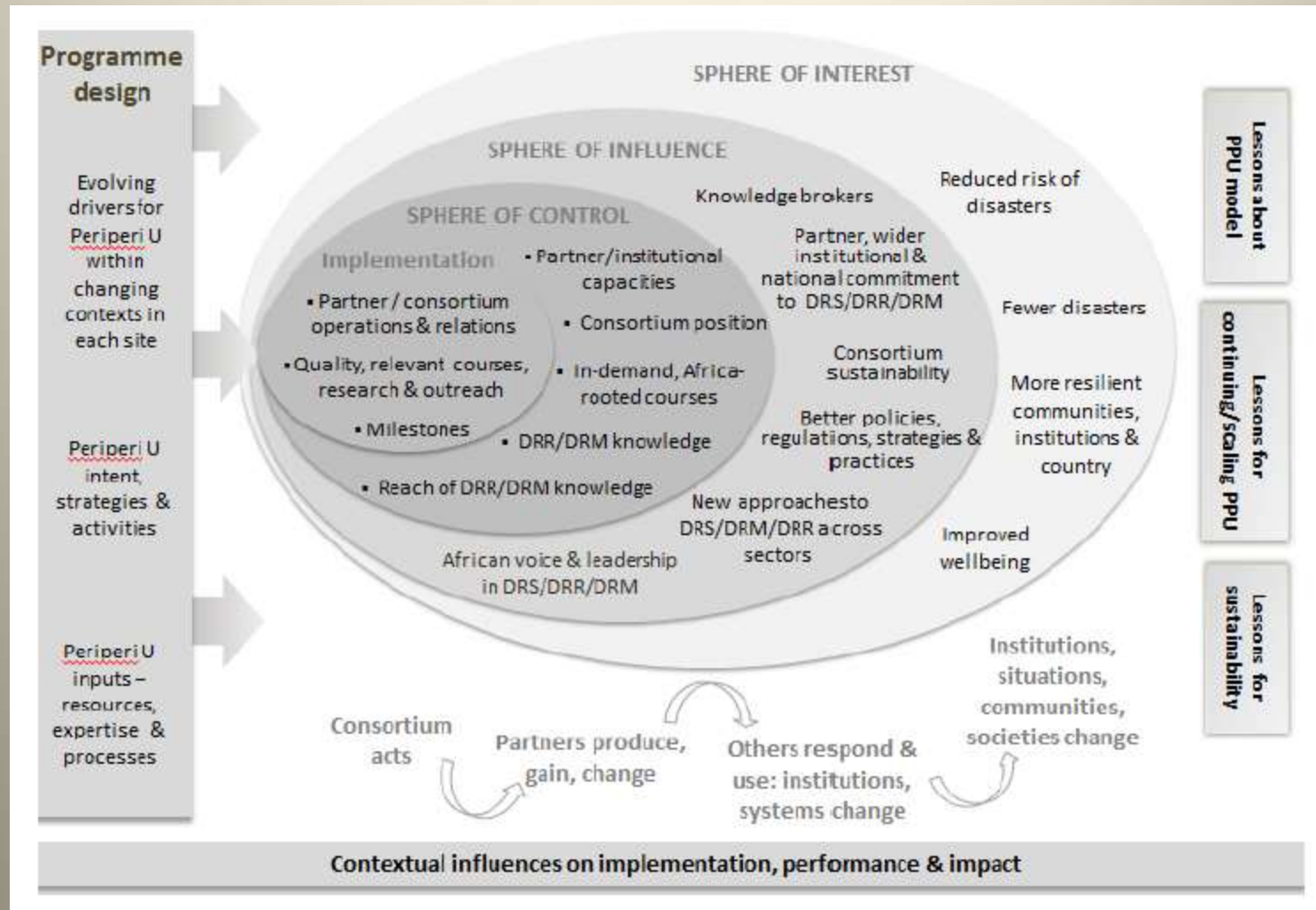
