Develop an MOU with IRDR

- Establish an Advisory Committee
 - UNISDR Africa/Geneva, ICSU ROA, IFRC
 - USAID/primary donor partner
 - National Research Foundation, South Africa
 - World Bank/African Development Bank, African Union
- Generate a work-plan that identifies focal areas for collaborative and individual research.


