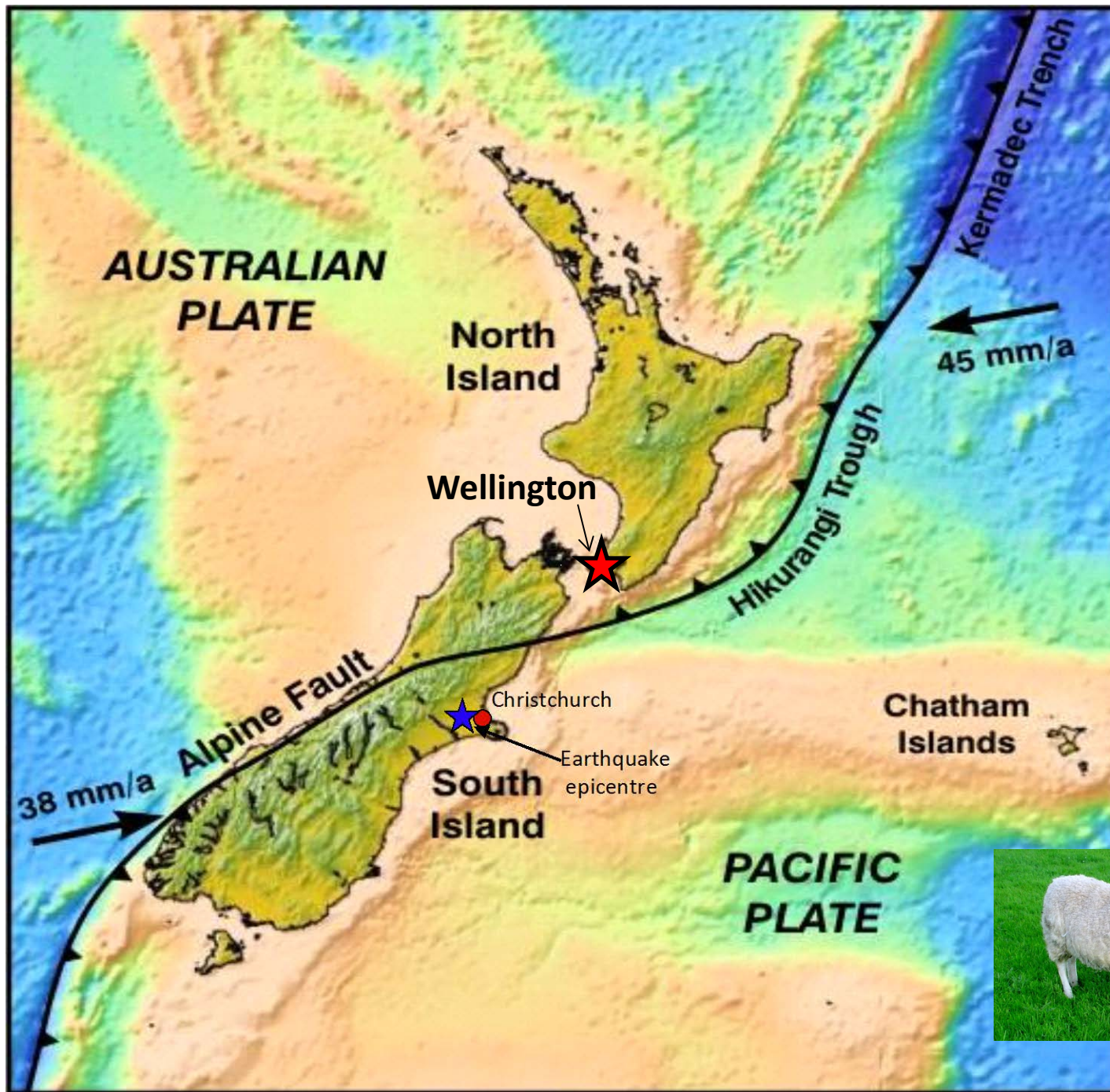

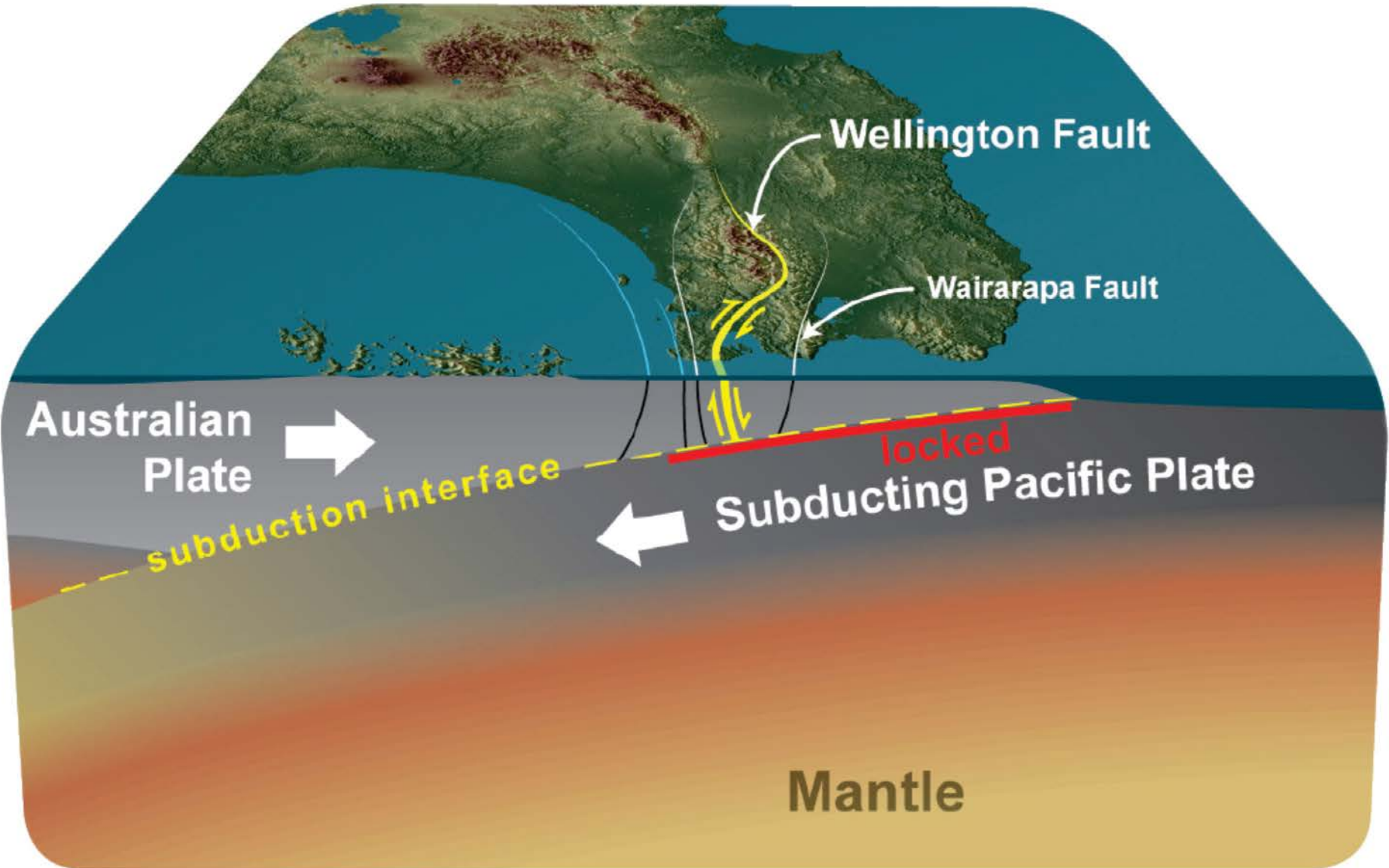

The key objectives of the ICoE:CR

- *Provide an evidence base for the Community Resilience Strategy.*
- *Act as a vehicle to share international good practice in Community Resilience.*
- *Promote the Wellington Region as a living laboratory for research and learning*

- In September 2014,. This half-day workshop entitled “*Community Resilience Workshop: Translating knowledge into action*” brought together participants from across the Wellington region

- The ICoE provided support for the successful application by Wellington City to become one of the Rockefeller Foundation's 100 Resilient Cities.
- The inaugural workshop of the PDRP program was held on 26th March 2015, and involved a number of key stakeholders across the region.

Next steps

- On the 12th August 2015, the JCDR will launch the 'Disaster Hub'. This will be a physical space on the Massey University Wellington campus, co-locating the Joint Centre for Disaster Research with partners from around the region and within the university, including many members of the ICoE.
